Review Projects

EDF will provide an up-to-date list of participating organizations and projects. You can indicate organizations you have a high interest in during the interview process, but cannot apply for a specific host organization.



Interview

Your interviews will be virtual. Early applicant interviews are in January to mid-February and regular applicant interviews are in mid-February to March.



Matches with host companies will happen at the end of February for early applicants and in the middle of March for regular applicants. You have two weeks to accept.



After you accept the match, we connect you with your potential host organization supervisor for final confirmation.
